Application Guidelines

Tiffin Women In Action (TWIA), is a philanthropic organization in Tiffin, Ohio providing both financial and volunteer support to women and children in Tiffin and Seneca County. Their primary form of providing financial support for women is through an annual post-secondary scholarship for women who meet required criteria.

Tiffin Women In Action welcomes scholarship applications from non-traditional female students residing in Seneca County Ohio who are currently enrolled in or have been accepted into a course of study through a fully accredited post-secondary educational institution. Scholarship awards will be sent directly to the educational institution in which the scholarship recipient is enrolled. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books and fees. Any unused funds shall be returned to Tiffin Women In Action.

To be eligible, scholarship applicants must:

- Have received a high school diploma or a GED certificate
- Have ended high school attendance at least one year prior to applying
- Have been accepted into a fully accredited post-secondary educational institution
- Provide a complete scholarship application to include required attachments
